



## Main Activities in Fiscal 2005

In fiscal 2005, we worked on three focus issues: contributing to the environment through our products, contributing to environmental conservation in business activities and contributing to environmental activities of society. As regards the issue “contributing to the environment through our products”, we finished building a production organization covering all production sites — including overseas — for environmentally friendly dot-impact printers that are free of lead, hexavalent chromium and other specific hazardous substances prohibited for use in the RoHS Directive. Thanks to these efforts, we expect to cut our annual use of lead by about 13 tons and our annual use of hexavalent chromium by about 8 kg. As regards the issue “contributing to environmental conservation in business activities”, we are pushing a restructuring in distribution at our production sites in China and started the operation of new transport routes at this occasion. Thanks to these efforts, we expect that the annual CO<sub>2</sub> emissions will be reduced by about 540 tons compared to fiscal 2004. As regards the issue “contributing to environmental activities of society”, we signed an agreement with the forest administration authority of Gunma prefecture on forest maintenance activities, etc. in the forest “Fureai-no Mori”, following the “Forest Parent Agreement” that we signed with Komoro city in Nagano prefecture in January 2005. The field given to Oki is a 5.4 ha area of the Kozukayama national forest in Terao-machi, Takasaki city, Gunma prefecture. An “Oki Group Fureai-no Mori” signboard was set up, and we will carry out forest volunteer activities (improvement cutting, climber cutting, bottom weed cutting, etc.) until the end of March 2010.

## Focus Activities for Fiscal 2006 (Framework)

Same as in fiscal 2005, we will aim for the realization of the “e-society”, aggressively and reliably promoting “contributions to the environment through our products — management and control of chemical substances contained in products”, “contributions to environmental conservation in business activities — promotion of measures to prevent global warming”, and “contributions to the environmental activities of society — environmental compliance” as the three pillars (points) of our environmental activities. In particular, we will position the following points as focus themes for fiscal 2006.
